2. What is the purpose/mission of the organization making the request?

Mission: Pure Water for the World's mission is to improve lives by empowering people with access to life's most basic necessities: safe water and sanitation. We do this by partnering with underserved communities, in Central America, primarily Honduras, and Haiti, providing the tools and education to establish sustainable safe water, sanitation and hygiene education programs. Our work encompasses community-based WASH programming, which includes filter installation, water system installations and renovations, latrine construction/repair, and hygiene education, as well as school-based programming which includes rainwater harvesting, handwashing stations, and latrine construction/repair, and hygiene education. We are proud to include menstrual hygiene management and practice as a part of our program curriculum.

3. Describe who, and how many, the project will serve:

PWW has 14+ years of experience working in Haiti implementing water, sanitation and hygiene education programs in homes, schools, and health clinics. In 2022, as a result of ongoing instability in the regions around the capital city of Port-au-Prince, PWW relocated its operations to Limonade, located near Cap-Haïtien in northern Haiti. The move has allowed PWW in Haiti to continue uninterrupted and has led to new partnerships and program opportunities.

Pure Water for the World is requesting \$5,000 from the Rotary Club of Elk Rapids to support WASH activities as our team continues to transition and adapt programming to Northern Haiti. This funding would help support PWW staff and PWW projects that are ongoing and changing lives for more than 2,000 individuals.

This request for a special contribution toward PWW's work will help fill in funding gaps and support PWW's efforts in the Limonade area, helping children and families in these communities.

The PWW team has been working extensively on projects including:

- Continued work and soon to be completed Rotary Global Grant in 520 homes (>20,000 people)
- Continued work implementing WASH in Limonade schools (~1,000 students)
- Focus groups for women, girls, men and boys related to menstrual hygiene management. This assessment currently being conducted will allow us to adapt a menstrual hygiene program to specifically target the needs related to menstruation, knowledge of menstruation, taboos and challenges.

Community mapping and data analysis has been conducted in one of the three communal sections in Limonade. This assessment will allow PWW to engage community leaders in the response to their WASH needs, create a tailored plan for each neighborhood to properly address their water and sanitation needs, with sustainability being the focus. It will also allow PWW to better partner with other organizations to address community needs.

The support from the Rotary Club of Elk Rapids would allow our team to continue these important projects that are improving the lives of children and families.
