Dan White – “The Folks of Flint...A Tribute”

Photographer Dan White spoke to club last week about his project The Folks of Flint...A Tribute, an exhibit of 58 large-print images of people of all walks of life from the Flint area. The show opened at the Capitol Theatre Aug. 23 and can be seen there through October 8. Some photos are in the lobby area and can be seen M-F from 8-5. The entire exhibit can be seen Thursday, Friday and Saturdays from 11-6.

White photographed both “regular” people and people who are well-known in the community. He started the project in 2016 in response to the water crises. He chose not to photograph the water crisis, but instead to focus on the people of Flint.

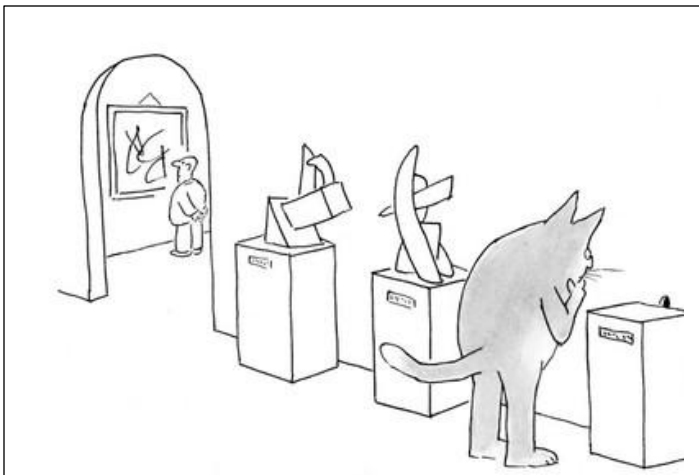
Ellen Brothers is back with us and we are glad to see her smiling face.
