## Speaker Round-Up

Our own Raphael Turner spoke to last week about what's new at Consumer's Energy. That includes their new Clean Energy plan, which includes commitments to protect the planet and serve nearly 7 million Michiganders, and 2023 will bring many changes that keep us, as an energy provider, and Michigan on the path to a carbon-neutral future.

The Clean Energy Plan calls for adding 8,000 megawatts of solar energy to the company's system by 2040. That will continue in 2023 as Consumers Energy closes our two coal-fired plants at the Karn facility in Bay County.

In 2023, CE will be reaching out to communities and landowners across Michigan to demystify solar generating sites, invite them to be part of the solution to Michigan's clean energy future and possibly host professionally constructed solar generating projects.

The company has also committed to supporting electric vehicles through PowerMIDrive, a program that will support 500,000 EVs on the road in Michigan by 2030. Drivers can expect strategically placed charging stations to make road trips a breeze.

Please welcome Lauren Coney and Dwayne Williams, and welcome back Vic George!







