Jason Scott – Lear Corp in Flint

Jason Scott, Global VP for GM Seating for Lear Corporation spoke to us last week about the company’s new facility in the Flint area, and its commitment to the community.

Scott described Lear as a tech company that does seating and a seating company that is on the leading edge of technology. The new Flint plant, opening soon, will house 600 employees in the 156,000-square foot facility on North Saginaw Street. The site includes 33 acres, of which 30 percent will be green space.

As part of their commitment to the community, Lear is refurbishing Flint Dort Park with new playground equipment and landscaping and clearing out old broken equipment and trash.

The company broke ground on the “just-in-time” facility in October. So far, they have hired 120 new employees, 86 of whom they have retained past the training phase.

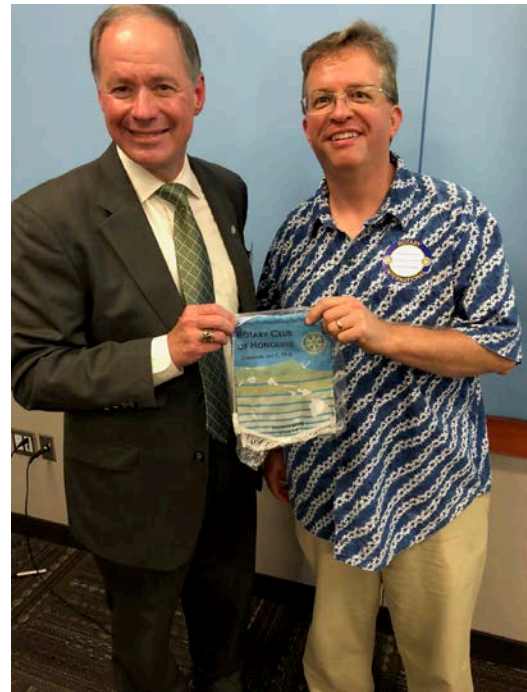
Health & Welfare

Ellen Brothers is recovering from surgery. Drop her a line or an email to tell her you are thinking of her.

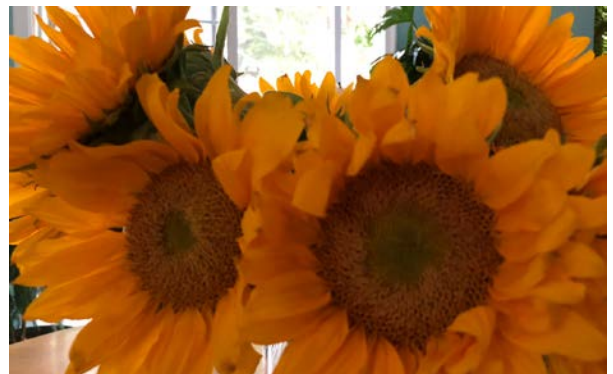
Paul Vanston has been in the hospital but is on the mend and hoping to be back at the keyboard very soon.
