# Presidential Roast Continued

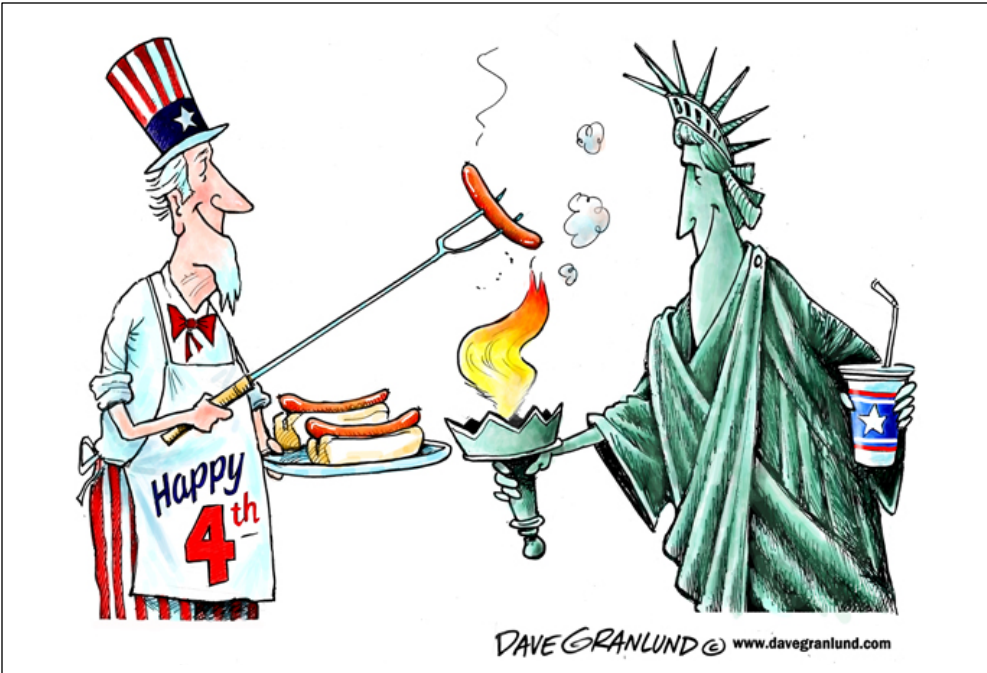
