

Genesee Valley Rotary Club  
Club Survey 2017  
As of Feb 15, 2018



The survey was emailed to the club's 41 active members, 3 bounced due to bad email addresses leaving 38 delivered. Of those 29 were opened and, we assume, read.  
To date, 20 (53%) were returned and recorded. Results are tabulated as follows.

*Meeting Frequency*

- 75% were satisfied with the current weekly meeting schedule
- 25% wanted to go to 2 meetings per month.

*Meeting Date & Time*

- 100% were satisfied with the current date & time

*Attendance Requirement Rule*

- 5% Require more than 50%
- 84% Leave requirement at current 50% level
- 5% Require less than 50%
- 5% Drop the attendance requirement

- 84% Continue to say the Pledge of Allegiance
- 11% Sing a patriotic song
- 5% Do nothing

*Spiritual recognition*

- 60% Continue with an opening prayer
