## Designed to Give Back to OUR Community

### 2014 – 2015 Accomplishments

- 1 Academic Scholarships – The Foundation awarded academic scholarships of \$1000 to 2 Novi High School students. The awards are made based on the information provided in the application and interviews with Novi Rotarians.
- 2 Technical Scholarships – The Foundation awarded technical scholarships of \$500 each to 2 students from the Oakland Schools Technical Campuses. These schools provide practical career technical education to high school students from Oakland County.
- 3 Special Education Scholarships – The Foundation awarded two scholarships of \$500 each to two special education students from Novi High School.
- 4 Most Improved Student Awards – The Foundation funded 10 awards of \$125 each for Novi High School's Most Improved Students. The students were selected by counselors and teachers based on improvement in grades, attendance and attitude. The students and their families were invited to a special Club luncheon to receive the award.
- 5 Ecuadorian Water Project – The Foundation funded a Novi Rotary Club initiative to conduct workshops and install bio-sand water filters in Cuenca, Ecuador.
- 6 Senior Citizen Holiday Luncheon – For the 38<sup>th</sup> consecutive year, senior citizens from all over Novi enjoyed an afternoon of holiday caroling led by the music department of Novi Middle School, a hot turkey lunch and the fellowship of Novi Rotarians.
- 7 Secured and matched a grant that will allow for the construction of a community Gazebo at Meadowbrook Commons, which will lead to the enjoyment and life enrichment of those in the community.
- 8 Worked in partnership with Novi Library to donate \$1500 to establish five (5) Read Boxes, that are placed in local parks and venues to expand the libraries reach through sharing and collecting of books to increase literacy and encourage the art of reading.
- 9 St. Christine's Food Kitchen – Novi Rotarians prepared food for the homeless and presented the organization with a check for \$1000
- 10 The Novi Feed the Need program was started this year to provide summertime lunches. Over 1650 children were served along with providing special events and art & crafts projects over an eleven (11) week period and three (3) different sites.
