

Plattsburgh Rotary Club Corporate Membership Information

What is a Corporate Membership?

2–4 employees of the same company or firm are designated and can join the Plattsburgh Rotary Club in a group application as Corporate Members. The designees can have various positions within the company but at least one should be a corporate executive.

What is the approval process?

The company or firm is nominated and sponsored for membership by a current Plattsburgh Rotary Club member in good standing. The corporation membership application is completed listing the 2–4 members who are applying and their titles and contact information. The stated approval process by the Membership Committee and Board of Directors is followed. The application form includes current involvement of the company and designees in the community.

How do we change designees?

If a change in one or more designees is necessary, a corporate membership application listing the new designee(s) will be completed and the same approval procedure followed. Membership fees for the new designee will be the same as any new member and be prorated for the remainder of the year. At least one corporate executive is required as a designee.

What are the dues for Corporate Members?

Each Corporate Member pays the same amount as an individual club member - \$100 for each 6-month period, January to June and July to December. There are no group discounts for Corporate Memberships.

What are the attendance requirements?

The Corporate Membership program reduces individual attendance requirements by allowing shared representation. As long as one corporate member attends a weekly meeting, all members receive credit. Each corporate member must attend at least once per month, and the group must collectively attend 70% of meetings each month. Multiple members attending the same meeting counts as a single attendance.

- All corporate members are welcome at each meeting.
- Corporate attendance can't exceed 100%.

Every Rotarian - corporate or individual - must attend at least one meeting per month in person.

What are the other Membership requirements?

Corporate members have the same (non-attendance) requirements as all members that will be reviewed in the new member packet and orientation or can be explained by current Rotarians.

What is the Induction process?

After Board approval, all new members receive a Red New Member Badge and have requirements that must be fulfilled before obtaining the Blue Membership Badge. New Member inductions are held during a regularly scheduled Plattsburgh Rotary meeting.

What are other Rotary benefits?

All members are actively registered with Rotary International, can access all benefits and will receive both the weekly electronic bulletin from the Club and monthly Rotarian Magazine.

Do corporate members have a vote?

Each attending corporate member vote counts as an individual active vote.

Additional information:

- Liability coverage and participation will be the same as for active members.
- Corporate member designees will be evaluated every six months for active attendance and participation in committees, which is the same as individual members.
