- Must either be a 501 C3 (or have a fiscal sponsor that is a 501 C3); a local city/town operated service; an educational institution; or operated by a church;
- Serve residents of central Maine;
- Provide food or basic necessities (ie, hygiene items, cleaning supplies, toilet paper, etc).
