- 4. What are your hobbies, recreational or athletic interests?
- 5. Identify a leader whom you admire, contemporary or historical and briefly explain why you selected this person.

In addition to answering the above questions, applicants need a letter of recommendation from A teacher or staff member at their school (it does not have to be a teacher for a current class; It can be from any teacher who knows you sufficiently to write a recommendation letter). The Letter need not be more than one-half page in length.
