Time commitment / Attendance

We meet, generally, in person weekly on Thursdays at 7:30 AM in the Senior Center at the South Burlington City Hall at 180 Market Street. Customarily, each meeting includes fellowship time, announcements, and an informational program about topics of interest in Vermont and/or internationally.

Members are expected to serve on one or more committees and to help out with the club's major fundraising events (Golf in the fall and Curling tournament in the spring).

Membership dues/Financial:

Members pay quarterly dues, adjusted annually according to costs of running the club. This year, July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2025, quarterly dues are \$56 (held steady from the last year). Club dues include membership dues for Rotary International.

In recent years our membership levels have remained steady with about 40 members, reflecting both an influx of new members and a leaving of existing members, a natural ebb and flow.

Additionally, we encourage members to donate annually to The Rotary Foundation, the giving arm of Rotary International. The Rotary Foundation is a highly effective global charity supporting multiple causes from disaster relief to early education, maternal health, conflict resolution and disease eradication.
