Guy Babb's Remarks:

THE FUTURE OF ROTARY IS IN YOUR HANDS

FOR ROTARY YEAR 2009-10 ROTARY INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENT JOHN KENNY HAS CHOSEN AS OUR THEME "THE FUTURE OF ROTARY IS IN YOUR HANDS." ROTARY WILL NOT BE SHAPED BY THE RI BOARD OF DIRECTORS, BY RI STAFF OR BY DISTRICT GOVERNORS. ROTARY IS-- AND SHOULD BE-- SHAPED IN EACH AND EVERY ROTARY CLUB. EACH CLUB MUST HAVE THE FREEDOM TO SERVE WHERE AND HOW IT CAN SERVE BEST. IN THESE CHALLENGING TIMES, IT IS FOR EACH OF US AS ROTARIANS TO DO WHAT IS NECESSARY TO KEEP ROTARY STRONG. WE ARE BUILDING ON THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF GENERATIONS OF PAST ROTARIANS. THEY CREATED THE ROTARY WE HAVE TODAY. BUT WE CANNOT OPERATE LIKE WE DID IN 1909, 1959 OR EVEN 1999. ROTARY WILL BE WHATEVER YOU AS ROTARIANS CHOOSE TO MAKE IT AND THEREFORE THE FUTURE OF ROTARY IS IN YOUR HANDS. HENRY FORD SAID, "WHETHER YOU THINK YOU CAN OR YOU THINK YOU CAN'T--YOU ARE RIGHT". ROTARY SHOULD SET A HIGH STANDARD; SET THE BAR HIGH. CLUBS CAN AND DO WORK TOGETHER; THEY WORK THOUGH THEIR OWN DISTRICTS, WITH OTHER CLUBS AND DISTRICTS WITH THE SUPPORT OF OUR FOUNDATION. TOGETHER ROTARY CAN.

YOU HAVE ALL SEEN THE LOOK IN THE EYES OF CHILDREN IN DISTRESS. YOU MAY KNOW UNDERSTAND THEIR LANGUAGE BUT YOU KNOW WHAT THEY ARE SAYING. OVER 20 YEARS AGO ROTARIANS LOOKED INTO THE EYES OF POLIO VICTIMS AROUND THE WORLD AND HEARD THE MESSAGE "PLEASE HELP ME". IN 1985 THERE WERE 350,000 NEW CASES OF POLIO PER YEAR OR JUST UNDER A 1000 A DAY NOW THERE ARE ABOUT A 1000 A YEAR. IT IS ESTIMATED THAT 5 MILLION CHILDREN HAVE BEEN SAVED FROM THIS CRIPPLING DISEASE BY ROTARY AND ITS PARTNERS.

WE AS ROTARIANS HAVE PROMISED THE WORLD THAT WE WILL ERADICATE POLIO AND WE CAN. WE HAVE GIVEN MILLIONS AND MILLIONS OF DOLLARS AND WE ARE CLOSE TO SUCCESS. WE CANNOT QUIT WHEN WE ARE ABOUT TO ACHIEVE THE GOAL. THE GATES FOUNDATION HAS GIVEN YOUR FOUNDATION \$355 MILLION DOLLARS AND CHALLENGES US TO RAISE \$200 MILLION IN 3 YEARS-- AND WE CAN DO IT. WE HAVE ALREADY RAISED OVER \$90 MILLION IN A YEAR. I ASK YOU TO DO A LOCAL EVENT TO RAISE FUNDS AND AWARENESS OF THE POLIO ERADICATION EFFORT.

ROTARIANS HAVE LOOKED INTO THE EYES OF YOUNG GIRLS IN INDIA AND OTHER COUNTRIES WHO HAVE BEEN SOLD INTO SLAVERY BY THEIR PARENTS. THE MESSAGE WAS "WILL ANYONE HELP ME". WE ARE ADDRESSING THE ISSUES OF EXTREME POVERTY TO HELP THOSE CHILDREN AND THEIR PARENTS.

ROTARIANS HAVE LOOKED INTO THE EYES OF YOUNG MOTHERS IN THE POOREST COUNTRIES OF THE WORLD WHO CANNOT FEED THEIR CHILDREN. THOSE EYES SAY, "CAN YOU HELP ME AND MY CHILDREN". WE ARE ESTABLISHING WATER AND SANITATION PROGRAMS, HEALTH AND HUNGER INITIATIVES AND MAYBE MOST IMPORTANTLY IN BREAKING THE CYCLE OF POVERTY ROTARIANS ARE STARTING EDUCATION AND LITERACY PROGRAMS FOR THE WOMEN AND GIRLS. ACCORDING TO AN AFRICAN PROVERB "EDUCATE A MAN AND YOU HAVE EDUCATED AN INDIVIDUAL - EDUCATE A WOMAN AND YOU HAVE EDUCATED A FAMILY". WE HAVE LEARNED THAT CLEAN WATER. HUNGER AND LITERACY ARE RELATED. IF THE WOMEN AND GIRLS - AND THEY ARE THE ONES THAT BEAR THIS BURDEN HAVE TO TRAVEL GREAT DISTANCES EACH DAY TO GET CLEAN WATER, THEY HAVE NO TIME TO ATTEND SCHOOL AND THE CYCLE OF POVERTY CONTINUES FOR ANOTHER GENERATION. WE NEED YOU TO CONTINUE YOUR GOOD WORK IN YOUR COMMUNITY AND AROUND THE WORLD AND FRANKLY WE NEED YOU FINANCIAL SUPPORT. WE NEED YOUR CONTINUED SUPPORT OF YOUR FOUNDATION, THE ROTARY FOUNDATION. PEOPLE OR FAMILIES OF GREAT WEALTH ESTABLISHED MOST OTHER LARGE FOUNDATIONS SUCH AS THE FORD FOUNDATION, GATES FOUNDATION, AND ROCKERFELLER FOUNDATION. YOUR FOUNDATION WAS STARTED BY A DONATION OF LESS THAN \$20 LEFT OVER FROM AN EARLY INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE. YOUR FOUNDATION IS FUNDED BY INDIVIDUAL ROTARIANS, AND CONTROLLED BY ROTARIANS. YOU CAN DETERMINE HOW THE FUNDS ARE SPENT. THE FUTURE OF ROTARY FOUNDATION IS IN YOUR HANDS.

BUT BEYOND YOUR FINANCIAL SUPPORT WE NEED YOUR INVOLVEMENT. WE NEED YOU TO LOOK INTO SOMEONE'S EYES AND RESPOND TO THEIR PLEA. YOU CANNOT SOLVE ALL THE WORLDS PROBLEMS BUT YOU CAN HELP SOMEONE. YOU CAN HELP BUILD A SCHOOL IN INDIA, DO A WATER PROJECT IN GHANA. YOU CAN DO WHATEVER YOU THINK YOU CAN DO. YOU HAVE FOUND YOUR ROTARY CLUB AND IT IS A GREAT CLUB. NOW YOU NEED TO FIND YOUR CAUSE.

WE NEED YOUR INVOLVEMENT AT THE CLUB LEVEL, THE DISTRICT LEVEL AND THE INTERNATIONAL LEVEL. THIS ROTARY YEAR YOU HAVE INCREDIBLE OPPORTUNITIES TO LEARN MORE STARTING WITH OUR DISTRICT CONFERENCE NEXT SPRING. WE HAVE HEARD VERY CLEARLY THAT YOU WANT A SHORTER, LESS EXPENSIVE DISTRICT CONFERENCE. YOUR DISTRICT CONFERENCE COMMITTEE HAS DECIDED TO DO A DAY AND A HALF CONFERENCE ON JUNE 11 AND 12, 2010 AT THE DAVIS CENTER AT THE UNIVERSITY OF VERMONT. WE ARE GOING TO HAVE FUN; WE ARE GOING TO FOLLOW IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF PAUL HARRIS WHO ATTENDED THE UNIVERSITY OF VERMONT. WE ARE GOING TO LEARN MORE ABOUT WHAT HAPPENED ON OCTOBER 31, 1886 THAT CAUSED PAUL HARRIS TO BE EXPELLED. WE ALSO BELIEVE THAT ROTARIANS LIKE TO BE ACTIVE SO WE ARE INCORPORATING SERVICE PROJECTS INTO THE CONFERENCE. WE NEED YOUR INPUT. PLEASE LET US KNOW WHAT YOU WANT AT YOUR CONFERENCE. "THE FUTURE OF ROTARY IS IN YOUR HANDS". ONE-WEEK LATER ON JUNE 20-23, 2010. THE ROTARY INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE WILL BE HELD IN MONTREAL.
