## **Program**

Manny introduced Jim Condos, the Vt. Secretary of State. Jim has been a Vermonter since his 4th birthday and held numerous positions in the Vermont state government. His family moved here to have a better life for their children.

In 2010 he was elected to his present position.

He asked his staff to get better organized and be able to respond more quickly to the public. He wanted them service oriented and to connect to the public.

Their department receives annual reports on all businesses. This process has now been computerized. They are also working on updating the election process to make it more accurate and reliable. Now registration can be done on line.

The state will not accept a vote by phone. They require a hard copy for security for absentee votes. Carolina had a problem as some people who mailed in votes ahead of time were dead by election day,

Another function of the state dept. is to issue and renew licenses for everything that requires a license. They have increased the number of professions that require licenses to protect the public. A board of peers decides whether or not to grant a license.

State archives are being updated. Some of the old maps go back to 1927 In 1976 transparency - access to public records was updated.

They try to have elections fair and free with access to government activities.

He states that a politician can't please everybody all the time - just be honest when you state your position and people will respect you.

If you don't vote, don't complain about what the government is doing!
