PROGRAM

Monk introduced Geordie Hall, who is a member of the Mad River Glen Ski Patrol, the Warren Fire Department, and the Ambulance Service for over 40 years.

The following are "bullets" Geordie sent me by e-mail.

- MRVAS covers four towns in the Valley providing ambulance and rescue services
- Response times for the ambulance may be long. Even up to 30 minutes or more in distant parts of the Valley.
- Call 911 as soon as you even think you might need the ambulance. Don't wait until it is too late. You can refuse treatment if you are capable of understanding what you are doing.
- Please show courtesy to emergency vehicles and volunteers responding to emergencies displaying red lights. Pull completely over to the side of the road and stop. It is state law that you must do this for emergency vehicles.
- MRVAS is a volunteer organization and takes no tax dollars from the local towns. Funding is from billing, grants, contributions and the annual subscription drive
- The annual subscription drive is just starting. There will be an ad in the paper the next three weeks and a mailing. MRVAS will still bill your insurance company for the transport. But if you have an annual subscription, you will not be charged anything directly.
- CVMC in Berlin is the hospital MRVAS transports to unless there is a medical reason to go somewhere else. MRVAS operates under medical control from a doctor at CVMC and they make the final determination. MRVAS does not usually transport to the orthopedic clinic at Sugarbush Lincoln Peak. But you can refuse our transport and call them to see if they will accommodate you.
- Ski patrollers and EMTs are not doctors. They do not diagnose. That is why they almost always recommend further medical treatment even if you refuse transport
