PROGRAM

Linda is a member of the Shelburne/Charlotte Rotary Club and is a leader of Hands to Honduras T. Linda has been involved with this program for 10 Years. Lois Knapp has participated for the last 5 years.

These ladies presented a very detailed slide show depicting what Hands to Honduras T has and plans to accomplish in Tela, Honduras and environs.

Over the past 10 years this group of volunteers have constructed and/or renovated classrooms(one with a retaining wall), outdoor kitchens, outdoor latrines, built playgrounds, fences where needed and many other projects. This past year a clinic for expectant mothers nearing the end of their term and waiting for labor to start was completed--it contained small rooms with beds, a lavatory with commodes, sinks etc. and a full kitchen.

Many volunteers participate in these projects and their tasks include administrative tasks, organizing the clinics, light labor such as painting as well as heavy labor The main project this year is building a Neonatal Intensive Care Unit for the Tela Hospital.

Funding for these projects is provided from donations, fundraising and District Simplified Grants.

Volunteers are welcome.

Sissy Walker led the 4 Way Test and the meeting was adjourned.
