PROGRAM

John Crump continued his presentation of the Mexican Rotary Club activities.

This time he explained how this club of only 42 members could raise \$250,000 - \$300,000.per year.

The money comes from their dues (\$350) and matching grants from the district and R. I. .Their meetings are every Thursday morning- 42 members and 20 from other clubs. Many of these guests return to their clubs in N. America with a list of needs for Mexico

They run several events such as a fashion show. Some company or individual will donate the cost of their expenses. Nothing goes to overhead.

Their biggest project is scholarships (\$95,000)

Feeding poor children is next. Every Monday they serve free food plus one piece of clothing to 50 - 100 kids in an enclosure near the dump (the poor section of town.) This may be their only protein. Kids take English and math courses. Rotary also pays for school books and a book mobile.

Medical supplies are high on the list.

Also water purification. 400 Families are given life saving 5 gallon buckets.

There is a wheel chair program which includes walkers and crutches.

A school orchestra has about 70 players and needs instruments.

A drug rehab. program is another project.

They cover just about every phase of life-giving materials to the poor

John Crump hopes our club will participate in their activities. It is all about education.
