Williston-Richmond Rotary meets every week on Thursday mornings. Club meetings feature interesting speakers, club business, shared inspiration and social networking.

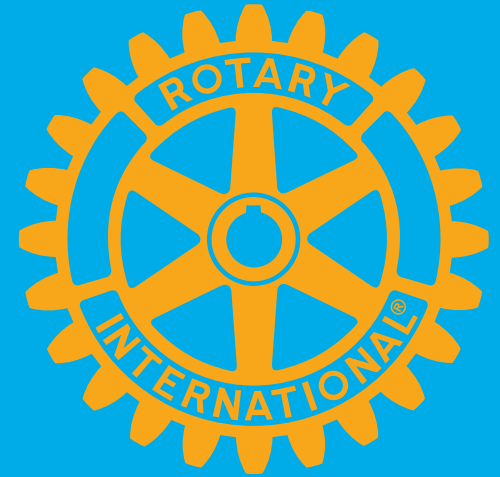
Service projects and social gatherings occur through the year.
