#### **BUDGET FOR 2024-25: \$20,000**

Budget to be set annually based on investment income. Per Larry Moss, our Raymond James investment advisor, investments are generating approx. \$10K per year.

Budget for 2024 – 25 is \$20K based on unused funds from the previous Rotary year.

#### **CURRENT / PROPOSED ALLOCATION: APPROVED**

Allocation can be changed annually by vote of Charities Board.

For 2024-25 allocation is as follows:

Vocational = 30% (or \$6000)

International = 10% (or \$2000)

Community = 60% (or \$12,000)
