5th Annual Rotary Flag Raising



The Middlebury Rotary Club is pleased to announce its Fifth Flag Raising Project to promote patriotism and to raise funds for charitable use in our community. We invite you to join your Middlebury neighbors by permitting us to display an American flag in one of several ways during the following time periods:

Memorial Day Weekend

Flag Day, June 14

Independence Day Weekend

Labor Day Weekend

Veteran's Day, November 11

In exchange for an annual \$50.00 subscription, our Rotarians will place one 3' x 5' flag on a 10' pole into a short pipe which is driven into the ground so it will not interfere with lawn maintenance. The flag will be installed just after sunrise and removed before sunset for storage until the next holiday. Seeing these flags throughout town is an impressive sight. Local charities are selected annually to benefit from your generosity and patriotism.

Homeowners and Businesses may select to have their flags on their lawns in front of their home or business, if they live close to town or the center of East Middlebury.

- OR -

Homeowners who live in outlying areas can have their flags flown at the top of the Town Green along Rt 7 with a small plaque engraved "in honor of" or "in memory of" a friend or family member.

- OR -

Businesses that do not have a lawn or are located away from the town center, may have their flag placed on Court Square opposite the Middlebury Inn. Signs and Newspaper articles will memorialize your generosity.

- OR -

Finally, for those who wish to honor a Veteran, Rotary will install a flag with many others in Canon Park opposite the Library. A Plaque with the Veteran's name, rank, branch of service and tour of duty will be affixed to the flag pole.
