We invite you to honor the life of a Veteran, either living or dead, as well as those on Active Duty, by permitting us to display an American flag in Cannon Park during the following time periods:

Veteran's Day, November 11

In exchange for a \$50.00 subscription, Rotarians will inscribe a 4" x 5" plaque with the Veteran's name, branch of service, tour of duty or years of service. The plaque will then be affixed onto a 10' pole (together with a 3' x 5' flag). All flags will be installed just after sunrise and removed before sunset for storage until the next holiday.
