The City of Auburn Hills and the Rotary Club of Auburn Hills cordially invite you to participate in the 2022 Summerfest Makers Market!

This is an outdoor show open to all artists and makers – please come and share your specialties with the northern Oakland County community: unique, hand-made items of art or crafts (no flea market items, used clothing, homemade foods, or drinks) – estimated attendance for this FREE two-day festival is 5,000 people.

**Date:** Friday and Saturday, June 24-25, 2022

**Event Times:** Friday 4pm – 8pm; Saturday 11am – 8pm

**Location:** Downtown Auburn Hills at Auburn Rd. & Squirrel Rd.

**Space:** 12' x 12'

**Fee:** \$75

**Deadline:** May 2, 2022

**Notification:** You will be notified of acceptance and pertinent information will be provided prior to the show.

#### **Market Rules & Regulations**

- 1. All Makers are required to use a tent or awning in their rented space, and must provide their own tent.
- 2. Spaces will be pre-assigned on a first-come basis. This is determined by receipt and approval of application, not on arrival at the event. Booth space is limited to <u>first 40 applicants</u>. Water hook-ups for booths are not available.
- 3. <u>Maker agrees</u> to be set up and ready by 3pm on Friday and by 10 am on Saturday No auto traffic will be allowed in the event areas during the event times, no exceptions. Please bring carts or wagons to transport your belongings. Entry to set-up on Friday begins at 9am. Rotary volunteers will be available for limited assistance, but it is highly recommended bringing someone to help with your setup.
- 4. <u>Maker agrees</u> to break-down no earlier than 8pm on Saturday night overnight security is provided on Friday night.
- 5. Maker is required to provide a tablecloth or other covering for display tables. *Tables are not provided*.
- 6. An air-conditioned Hospitality Area will be provided. Artisans must have a badge (provided) to enter. Two badges per space will be provided at check-in the morning of the event.

- 7. <u>Maker agrees</u> to conform to all rules and regulations, and will follow instructions by authorized personnel of this event, or vendor will be asked to leave the event immediately, forfeiting refund of rental space fee.
- 8. No refunds will be made for cancellation after acceptance into the show.
- 9. Notification of event cancellation due to severe weather will result in refunds to vendors and notification will be made in advance if at all possible.
- 10. No political booths allowed.
- 11. The City of Auburn Hills is not responsible for damages, loss or theft of merchandise, supplies, or other property.
