Both cities and law enforcement feel challenged to come up with adequate measures to insure safety and health of the citizens. Also brought out was the complications brought on by the lack of interface between state and federal laws with regard to legalization.

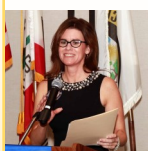

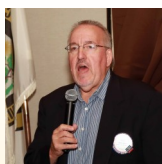
Minutes of Meeting
