Haider Alawami introduced our speaker for today. He noted that Al Adam is Council Member and Immediate former 51st Mayor of the City of Thousand Oaks and is also a Managing Director of Investments for Wells Fargo Advisors. He is focused on economic development and the preservation of our environment. Al was elected to the City Council in 2012 after serving our community



in various capacities including Planning Commissioner, YMCA Chair, founder of the Alliance for the Arts and Chair of the Civic Arts Plaza Board of Governors.

Adam thanked the club for inviting him and started his talk with several funny stories. He then pointed to the slides and showed what Thousand Oaks Boulevard has looked like over the years. Referring to the heated discussions over the years as to the development of the boulevard, he linked the current plans with the need for a venue that would draws younger residents into Thousand Oaks. This can be done, he said, when there is mixed use availability. He showed how other cities created residences and restaurants in the same complex, drawing people into the downtown area.

Al then showed a proposed picture of a mile-long section of the boulevard, suggesting that as the beginning of an ongoing asset of the city.
