Anna Winningham shared uplifting and thought=provoking stories of her years with the FBI. She spoke of her early years, wanting to be a spy even while young.

She joined the army and was in the 82nd Airborn Division and oddly enough was afraid of heights. As a parachutist she taught herself how to face her fears and figure ways to surmount them.

Another story she told dealt with her FBI career. She didn't want to work with either the drug scene or terrorists. Predictably she found herself ensconced in work dealing with both. She confessed that it was one of the most rewarding times in her career.

Anna compared her work with the FBI Special Forces to Rotary. Whether it was SWAT or Hazmat or something else, "we do extra above and beyond our careers to do good for others.

Finally she suggested three lessons learned from her experience:

- 1) Don't reinvent the wheel but be courageous enough to make changes.
- 2) Sometimes to need to break the rules to make things happen.
- 3) You can't control everything.
