**Jennfer Strong** introduced our speaker today, Bill Dallas. Bill is known for building two mortgage companies from the ground up, First Franklin and Ownit Mortgage Solutions. He is also the founder of InterThinx, MindBox, California Oaks State Bank, and Heritage Bank of Commerce.

Bill is enthusiastic about education and entrepreneurship, and among other things promotes California Lutheran as a developer of young entrepreneurs, new business concepts and start-up companies.

Bill pointed out many differences between "our" generation and those in "today's" generation - perhaps the 20-40 range. He demonstrated this by listing some words that only our generation used, such as pocket-book, whippersnapper, tape (tape this for me), Xerox, floppy disk, cassette tape, album, 8-track, CD, groovy, stewardess, ice box, dungarees, pay phone, fax, yellow pages, Chamber of Commerce, Rotary — and the number one strange word is Job.

The infiltrating of technology and mobility has blown apart jobs. Referring to it as the "gig" economy. 50% of the workforce in 2019 will be part of that economy. These are contractors, freelancers, part-timers, consultants, agile workers. The "gig economy" is entrepreneurship. Examples of probably the ten top "gigs" are delivery truck driver, multimedia artist, carpenter, broadcast and sound engineer, accountant, software developer, occupational therapist, web developer, interpreter/translator, and analyst.
