#### **ROTARY AND THE UNITED NATIONS**

**Jere Robings** 

Louis Curran-Klein introduced our own Jere Robings, a forty-four year Rotarian and past president of the Simi Valley club. Jere's interest in the subject began at an International Convention where he met a speaker from the World Bank in Geneva. Then while attending the Vatican's Rotary Jubilee in Rome, Jere ran into Ed Futa ,the former RI General Secretary and now Dean, United Nations Representatives. His work was appointing Rotarians to 31 UN agencies in locations around the world; fifteen in foreign capitals. This led Jere to serious research as to why Rotary had this position.

In 1940, when Rotary was 35 years old, war had begun in Europe and the International Rotary Convention that year adopted a Human Rights Resolution that eventually became the basis for the UN Declaration of Human Rights. In 1942, Rotarians convened in London to address the issue of world peace. Diplomats, ministers, and representatives of 21 governments attended, and the results was a forum that eventually resulted in what is now UNESCO.

At the Dumbarton Oaks conference, where Russia, China, Great Britain and the US met to create an international organization to maintain peace, Rotarians from around the world were invited as working observers in the meetings. The next year Rotary was invited by the US Secretary of State to send consultants to the UN Charter Conference. 23 Rotarians, 11 from the US, guided agendas, performed translations, suggested working resolutions, and helped resolve disputes among delegates. Rotarians now participate in many UN agencies and many leaders involved with the UN are Rotarians.


## **Thousand Oaks Rotary Meeting**


