Nate Harimoto introduced Ann, who spoke of how pleased parents, grandparents and families are of the CVUSD, and how families bring their children here from outside of the area. She polled our club to see how many have attended any of the schools in CVUSD and how many had children or grandchildren attend CVUSD. Nearly all Rotarians raised their hands at some point during her polling.

She covered the current budget and the difficulties meeting their budgets. They have stopped borrowing into next year's budget to cover current year (which was a common practice until now). She covered the possible closure of schools due to lack of youth population. The more school closures, the less funding the district receives. They are now budgeting for school nurses and therapy counseling.

Her philosophy in working with the students is to be innovative in working with the children with their academics and extra curricular activities.

The population of the schools is racially diverse: about 50% white, 20% Asian, 20% Hispanics, 1% Black, 4% other. 22% of student population is on subsidized breakfast and lunch.

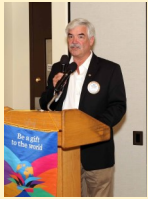

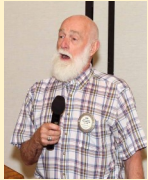

Our beloved member, **Phil Sheridan**, attended our weekly club meetings.



He truly enjoyed attending our meetings every week, Club member, **Karen Furnari**, graciously brought Phil to our club meetings and returned him to his home every week because he was in declining health and needed her assistance to attend our meetings. Unfortunately, as **Phil** was leaving our club meeting last week and was attempting to get into his car with the assistance of **Karen**, he collapsed and was never revived.

Phil was born on December 8, 1922. He received his BA and JD degrees from George Washington University in Washington DC. He took the Washington DC Bar exam and passed it. He then became a lawyer and member of the Washington Bar Association. From January of 1941 to December of 1945 **Phil** served in the United States Army Infantry. He was stationed for 32 months in the Pacific Theater. He then served the remainder of his tour of duty in Japan with our occupation forces.

Phil was employed by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. He was then employed by General Telephone in Industrial Security. Prior to joining our club, **Phil** was a member of the Norfolk Virginia Rotary Club and the Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania Rotary Club. He was a Paul Harris Fellow.
