Rotary Club of Thousand Oaks Meeting March 3, 2016



Jim Friedl (on behalf of **Sevak**) encouraged us to go to the




Give Back Game on Saturday, March 12th. There will be several teams and games, and Rotary plays Kiwanis at about 5:00 p.m. Flyers on the tables.
