# Los Robles Hospital—Intervention & Growth



**Lois Curran-Klein** introduced our speaker today, Amy Commons, Vice Chairman of the Los Robles Board of Trustees of Los Robles Hospital.

LRH was built in 1968, and now has four campuses: main campus, east campus in Westlake Village, surgical hospital on Rolling Oaks drive; and imaging center in

Moorpark. Amy went on to tell us about many of the programs and capabilities of the hospital now, such as the robotics program started 2010, trauma center, pediatric care, wound care, etc. Everything is cutting edge and state of the art.

They are still in the process of expanding both facilities and services: for instance, expanding the radiology department; doubling the emergency department over the next 15-18 months. They are introducing 5 new emergency care facilities: Agoura, Westlake, Simi Valley, Thousand Oaks and Camarillo.

Los Robles Hospital is one of only five hospitals in the US with the official standing of "Hospital of the Future."
