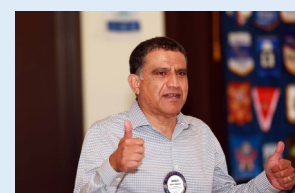

- 8 – the number of new cases of polio this year in the world
- 12 – Last year in Atlanta, 12 representatives of different nations stepped forward with Bill Gates and thanked Rotary for their work in eradicating polio.
- 30 – Thirty years ago we launched the polio program in Philadelphia. The nations of the world brought forth their pledges, which came to \$240,000,000.
- 16 million – people who have avoided polio because of our work.

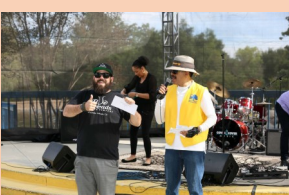
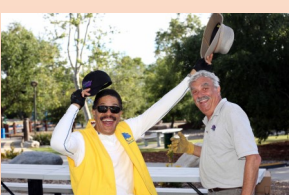
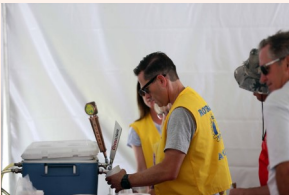
