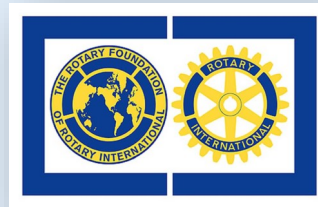

The program was presented by Dr. Mary Contini Gordon and our own **Bob Lewis**. It was the story of Charlie Cooke; the story of collaboration on behalf of cultural and natural heritage.
