Introduced by our own rocket scientist **Richard Williams**, Astronaut Jim "Vegas" Kelly, among other distinctions, is a retired Air Force Colonel. Astronaut Kelly has participated in two trips to the international Space Station and has logged 641 hours in space. Richard speculated that the total was probably more than the rest of us combined. (*Not sure about that.*)

He called the Space Station the most amazing engineering project of all time. Larger than 3 football fields, it is expected to continue in operation until 2028. He presented a video describing some of the highlights of space travel including liftoff, orbit, experiments on the human body, working out in space, types of food, and watching weather form in space. Clearly the highlight of the talk was a description of the human waste elimination and reconstitution process in space. Thankfully, his talk took place after lunch.

## **Rotary International Brings Us Together**




The Tijuana Rotarians made a short presentation at our meeting.


- They shared with us important news: that their club is going to be 85 years old.
