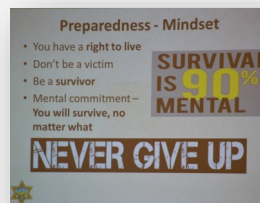

ACTIVE SHOOTER, aka WORKPLACE VIOLENCE

Ventura County Sheriff Department



Sergeant Brian Slominski, a 20 year veteran of the Ventura County Sheriff's Office, gave a presentation on workplace violence. During his tenure on the department, he has worked assignments such as Patrol, K-9, Investigations, Intelligence Led Policing, and now is the supervisor of the Sheriff's Gang Unit. Sergeant Slominski is a recognized expert in workplace violence and produced the Ventura Sheriff's Office Active Shooter training program. He has presented this program to many diverse organizations, including schools and universities.

He stressed the importance of the three directives: Run-Hide-Fight. Recognizing that workplace violence might raise fear in people, he urged people to remind themselves that they can control their thoughts which can control their survival. If they know they can endure, they will increase their chances for survival, even if they have to devise creative ways to fight the assailant.
