## **Issues and Resolutions**

#### Lack of members support during event planning phase

 Members can help out in various ways: Time, Money (personal donations or enlisting sponsors), and Resources

#### Lack of volunteers during event for various sections

- Members who agree for times and sections must show up, or areas will be left un-manned!
- Be familiar with your expected duties for each section

#### Ticket Sales

- Tickets confirmed must be paid for preferably before the event
- All tickets used must be paid for in a timely fashion after close of event

## Issues and Resolutions cont'd

#### • Event Sections – Gate Sales / Silent Auction / Bar Sales / Raffle

- Be familiar with the sections and what is expected
- Accurate records must be kept at the gate of tickets sold, returned, exchanged tickets and prices
- Members are not allowed to insert their own starting bid or increments for silent auction prizes
- Keep accurate record of drink tickets sold, type of ticket and prices
- Prizes donated for the event are for club profit (club or community account) and are not be sold at the event
- Any issues that arise during the event inform the Fundraising Chair and committee members

#### • Event Charges

- Please be aware of what is covered under the ticket price and what is not
- Items not covered under the ticket price must be paid for by yourself and your guests and not charged to the club account
