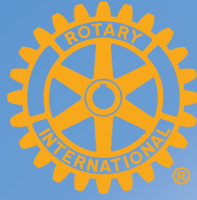

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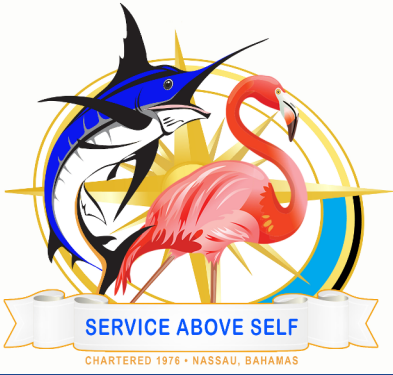
GUEST SPEAKER: MR. R. BRENT THOMAS DECKER



The mission of **CURE VIOLENCE** is to reduce violence globally using disease control and behavior change methods. Cure Violence was founded by Gary Slutkin, M.D., former head of the World Health Organization's (WHO) Intervention Development Unit and Professor of Epidemiology and International Health at the University of Illinois/Chicago School of Public Health. **CURE VIOLENCE** launched in West Garfield Park, one of the most violent communities in Chicago, and was quick to produce results, reducing shootings by 67% in its first year.

R. BRENT DECKER is the Chief Program Officer at **CURE VIOLENCE** based at the University Of Illinois School Of Public Health. Mr. Decker began at **CURE VIOLENCE** in 2003 and has worked with a wide range of US and International partners to adapt, design, and provide ongoing technical assistance on the implementation of the **CURE VIOLENCE** health based violence prevention model. The model has been successfully implemented in 53 community based sites in 25 cities globally and has been independently evaluated by the National Institute of Justice, the Center for Disease Control, Bureau of Justice of Assistance, and the University of Chicago.

MR. DECKER holds a Masters of Public Health (MPH) in International public health and development and a Masters of Social Work (MSW) in clinical social work from Tulane University. Before joining **CURE VIOLENCE**, Mr. Decker worked on a number of social justice and community health projects in Latin America.
