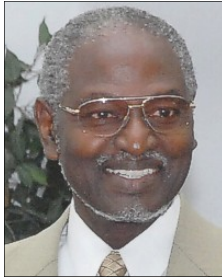

He actively serves not only the community with great medical care but the Adventist Church as well. His missionary spirit compels him to give of his time and talents to better the lives of people in need. As an Adventist physician, he closes his clinic on Sabbaths (Saturdays). **Last Week's Speaker s Highlights –
Dionisio J. D'Aguilar, MBA, CPA.,
Director, President & CEO of Superwash Limited**

Topic: Energy Cost Impact Superwash

Some of Mr. D'Aguilar speech highlights were as follows:

- 1) Mr. D' Augilar stated that Superwash has regained some profit but is still struggling to keep up with energy costs, since its profits declined in 2008 by two percent.
- 2) The President of Superwash said that in 2009 profits went down by 6.9 percent and continued to fall some 4 percent in 2010.
- 3) Mr. D' Augilar added that in 2011 all that changed. His company experienced an increase in sales.
- 4) Mr. D'Aguilar mentioned that his company uses more propane than any other business on the island and is second to Atlantis, Paradise Island. Due to the increase in BEC costs and the increase in costs for propane, we are paying some \$21,000.00 just for energy. Although BEC and propane have increased we have not been able to increase our service costs.
- 5)Mr. D'Aguilar added that besides the increase in energy costs ,many Laundromats have been affected by the New Providence Road Improvement Project (NPRIP).
- 6)Lastly, the President of Superwash added that he hopes the improvements to the roads are completed before the 2012 general elections and that 2012 will be a better year for those businesses impacted.
