II. Selection Criteria

A. Applications will be judged by the scholarship committee and evaluated based upon the following:

- 1. Community Service and volunteer activities.
- 2. Extracurricular activities
- 3. Letter of recommendation (at least one) from teacher, clergy, or employer.
- 4. Written presentation on the following:

"There is an overwhelming number of worthy causes to focus attention on. In your opinion, what do you feel is the most important humanitarian issue today and what can we as Americans can do to help alleviate the situation." Please explain in 500 words or less.

B. Completed applications will consist of (1) **application**, signed and dated, along with (2) **a letter of recommendation** and (3) **essay**.

C. Students who are chosen as finalists will be required to have an interview with the scholarship committee.

D. Students will be judged on the basis of merit, taking into account all the information obtained on the application, the essay and the interview.

E. Financial need is not a criteria.

F. Winners will be announced at the respective High School Commencement Exercises and presented the award at a Rotary Breakfast Meeting.

III. Amount of the Scholarship is \$ 2,000.

IV. Scholarship will be paid directly to the institution, by the Rotary Club Committee Chairman, upon presentation of the institution's tuition bill.
