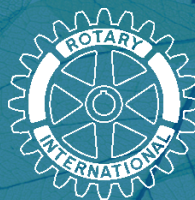

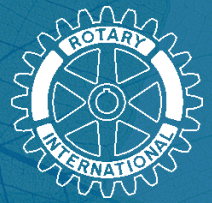

All Rotary Clubs share a key mission: to serve their communities and those in need throughout the world. Locally, the Rotary Club of Flushing has a long history of community service:



- Support of community events such as S'mores at the Candle Walk Festival and the Scarecrow Contest for the Harvest Festival
- Support of the food pantry at the Flushing Christian Outreach Center and the building and installation of benches along the Flushing River Trail
- Improving literacy through Rotary Readers at Seymour Elementary School and financial support of Literacy programs in the Flushing Schools with the proceeds from the annual Huge Indoor Garage Sale
- Providing scholarships to Flushing High School graduates who demonstrate both academic and service accomplishments
- Providing an annual Service Above Self award to a non-Rotarian community member whose volunteer or

professional accomplishments embody the Rotarian ideal of service in business, personal and community life

- Supporting improvements to Riverview Park through the underwriting of the master plan in 2011 and the replacement of the bench seating with stadium seats in 2013
- Sponsoring of the Interact Club at Flushing High School
- Recognizing outstanding student leaders with the Student of the Month presentation for Flushing High School and Middle School students
