

DISTRICT 6330 APPLICATION PROCESS FOR A 2015-2016 GLOBAL GRANT SCHOLARSHIP

1. Information regarding Global Grant Scholarships and the application form to be used to apply for a Global Grant Scholarship is available on the Rotary District 6330 web site: www.rotary6330.org and downloading:

- Global Grant Application Process
- Global Grant Application Form

2. Completed application forms should be emailed to local Rotary clubs by **October 15, 2014**. At the time of this phase, the applicant must know where he/she wants to study.

3. Interviews, either in person or by SKYPE, should be held by local Rotary clubs to endorse candidates whose completed applications have been received in time to allow club-endorsed applications to be forwarded by email to the scholarship subcommittee chair, Johnna Johansen (jjohansen1@cogeco.ca) by **October 31, 2014**. Once received, the chair will confirm with TRF that the candidate's study program and career goals are eligible.

4. One district-endorsed Global Grant Scholarship candidate will be selected following an **interview in person or by SKYPE** from the pool of club-endorsed applicants at a location in Sarnia, Ontario on a Saturday in **November, 2014**.

5. The successful candidate will be notified by telephone the weekend of the interview.

6. Unsuccessful candidates will be notified by email the weekend of the interview.

7. Once the **proposal** has been approved, it will be the responsibility of the scholarship candidate to gain admission to the proposed educational institution. DEADLINE to gain admission is the date when the district-endorsed application is submitted to TRF. **Proposed deadline: January, 2015.**

8. The District 6330 Scholarship Subcommittee, along with the assigned sponsor counselor, will help identify a primary contact in the host district of the educational institution where the scholarship candidate wishes to pursue post-graduate studies. This primary contact will assist in finding a primary HOST sponsor club and HOST counselor within the host district.

9. Once the District 6330 Global Grant Scholarship Candidate has been determined and a Host Counselor has been found, the district endorsed scholarship candidate, with help from the district scholarship subcommittee, sponsor counselor and host counselor, will complete and submit the formal application on line for The Rotary International Foundation. **Proposed deadline: February 28, 2015.** Hopefully, a decision will be reached by TRF prior to May 31, 2015.

10. The successful global grant scholarship candidate will receive a mandatory orientation following approval by TRF before the scholarship year begins. If there is a cost for orientation, the sponsoring club may be asked to cover the cost of hotel accommodation.
