Chuck Long to Speak on October 8th



Former Iowa Hawkeye quarterback **Chuck Long** is scheduled to speak to the noon Rotary Club of Ankeny on **October 8th.** Chuck is a member of the College Football Hall of Fame and played professionally in the NFL for the Detroit Lions and Los Angles Rams. After his professional career, he served as an assistant coach at Iowa and Oklahoma and head football coach at San Diego State. Long is the CEO and Executive Director of the Iowa Sports Foundation, the organization that runs the Iowa Games, the

Senior Games and the Live Healthy Iowa challenge.

Chuck will be talking about his recently published biography "Destined for Greatness - The Story of Chuck Long and Resurgence of Iowa Hawkeyes Football." It relives his life and career as one of the Hawkeyes' greatest players and the resurgence of Iowa football under Coach Hayden Fry. The book also includes perspectives from Fry, Kirk Ferentz, Hap Peterson, Mark Vlasic and Jonathan Hayes and their reflections on a variety of topics including the farm depression that impacted lowa in the 1980s. Chuck plans to share his memories of taking a snap in a record five college bowl games, claiming a last-second win over No. 2 Michigan in 1985, finishing runner-up to Bo Jackson for the 1985 Heisman Trophy and being selected in the first round of the 1986 NFL Draft by the Detroit Lions. This would be a great opportunity to invite a guest and prospective new members to attend a Rotary meeting!!

During the meeting on September 4th, President Ben Digmann named Carmen Davis the "Rotarian of the Month" for September. This was in recognition of her coordinating the volunteers for the parade set up at Summerfest.

Board Approves Donation to Meals From the Heartland



At their meeting on September 13th, the Board approved a donation to Meals From the Heartland in the amount of \$100. This donation is to help Heartland pay for the cost of the food ingredients, packaging, and transportation

costs for the meals the Evening club packaged on August 23rd. That evening they packaged 756 bags. Each bag will provide 6 meals which equals a total of **4,536 meals** packaged by Rotarians and guests..

The meals that are packaged contains rice, soy protein, minerals, and dried vegetables including carrots, onions, tomatoes, celery, cabbage, and bell peppers. The packages are distributed globally, most commonly to orphanages and schools. Oftentimes, children in developing areas will only eat one meal a day and when these meals are distributed at schools it ensures they get nutrition and an education. The cost of each package is \$1.20 which equals \$.20 per meal. A total of **3,626,208** meals were packaged during the 4-day period of Meals From the Heartlands 11th annual hunger fight.

Board Decides to Discontinue Dictionary Distribution



The Rotary Club of Ankeny has distributed dictionaries to Ankeny 4th graders in each of the **past 12 years**. This has amounted to a total of **9,912 dictionaries**. This service project has been one of the club's most popular activities with great participation from members to help facilitate

the distribution and the dictionaries have always been well received by the students and their teachers. However, we now understand each Ankeny 4th and 5th grader has received a Chromebook which would mean the dictionaries would be used very little. The Board has, therefore, decided to discontinue distributing dictionaries to Ankeny 4th graders.

Remaining Calculators To Be Donated



A few years ago the club acquired about 25,000 small solar powered calculators from past District Governor John Ockenfelds. These calculators were destined to be trashed if Gary Welch had not said our club would take them. For the past 3 years, we have been giving a calculator with each dictionary that we distributed annually to 4th graders. A few of the calculators found there way to Cozumel with Dean Lange and others some have been donated to churches for mission trips

to Africa but we still have over 14,000 in storage in a warehouse being provided by CJM Financial.

The club has now been contacted by a representative of **Samaritan's Purse** about our club donating some or all of the remaining calculators to their organization. Samaritan's Purse is a nondenominational Christian organization that provides spiritual and physical aid to victims of war, natural disasters, disease, famine, poverty, and persecution in more than 100 countries. They are headquartered in Boone North Carolina with affiliate offices in Canada, the United kingdom, Germany, and Australia as well as field offices in 16 developing countries. Their President and CEO is Franklin Graham, son of Billy Graham.

Samaritan's Purse has a project, Operation Christmas Child, that collects gift wrapped shoeboxes filled with gifts such as school supplies, hygiene items, and fun toys and delivers them to children in need around the world. For many of these children the gift filled shoebox is the first gift they have ever received. We believe a small solar powered calculator will make a great addition to the gifts in the shoeboxes. At their September meeting, the Board for the Rotary Club of Ankeny agreed to donate all remaining calculators to this project. A local volunteer from Operation Christmas Child will be the speaker at our noon meeting on September 25th to provide us with more information regarding this project.
