On February 23, 2010, Rotary International will be celebrating its 105<sup>th</sup> birthday. Rotary International was the world's first service club. On that date the first Rotary club of Chicago, was formed by Paul P. Harris, an attorney who wished to capture, in a professional club, the same friendly

spirit he had felt in the small towns of his youth. The Rotary name derived from the early practice of rotating meetings among members' offices. Rotary's popularity spread, and within a decade, clubs were chartered from San Francisco to New York to Winnipeg, Canada. By 1921, Rotary clubs had been formed on six continents. The organization adopted the Rotary International name a year later.

Remember the definition of Rotary, "Rotary is an organization of business and professional persons united worldwide who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations, and help build goodwill and peace in the world."

# **Past District Governor Paul Hellwege**

It is with great sadness that we recognize the death of Past District Governor, Judge Paul Hellwege. Paul went to join his beloved Phoebe at 2:10 p.m., January 28, 2010, after being hospitalized for the past week.

Judge Hellwege was twice appointed as District Court Judge. In 1958, he was

appointed the first Democratic judge in the then 11th Judicial District since 1894. He served as a District Court Judge until April 30, 1981, and as a Senior Judge until December 10, 1991.

Judge Hellwege has been a member of the Boone Rotary Club since 1948. He is a Past President of the Boone club, was District Governor in 1954-55, and served on Rotary's Council on Legislation on four occasions. He is a Paul Harris Fellow, a Rotary Foundation Benefactor and in 1994 received the Foundation's Citation for Meritorious Service. In 2007, he received the Foundation's highest honor, the Distinguished Service Award.

Visitation will be on Saturday, February 6th at 9:00 a.m. followed by services at 10:00 a.m. at the Augustana Lutheran Church, 309 South Greene Street, Boone, IA 50036.
