### **Rotary Meeting Attendance**

June, the last month of Rotary's fiscal year, will soon be upon us. Now is a good time to review our attendance numbers for both the club and members.

We currently have 15 members with perfect attendance for the year and several other members that are within one or two make-ups of acheiving perfect attendance for the year. Each member can check their own attendance by logging into our web site and clicking on "My Attendance" under "My ClubRunner". If you have any questions regarding your attendance, contact Nate Burnham.

Through April, our club has averaged 37.2 members in attendance at each meeting. This is slightly higher than for the past couple years of 33.3 in 2007-2008 and 34.0 for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. The Ankeny club usually ranks in the top 1/4 each month of all the clubs in District 6000 in attendance percentage. Our average attendance, including make-ups, for this year through April has been 78.5%. This is also slightly higher than for the past several years, as shown below:

2005-2006 - 68.6%

2006-2007 - 69.7%

2007-2008 - 74.1%

2008-2009 - 75.5%

2009-2010 - 78.5% (through April, 2010)
