The Ankeny Rotary Club was one of 10 Des Moines area Rotary Clubs that participated in a fundraising effort with the Iowa Energy on January 23, 2010.

Rotarians were given the opportunity by the Iowa Energy to sell tickets to the game with a portion of the proceeds being donated to our Polio Plus effort. Also, fans had the opportunity to participate in a 50/50 raffle and contribute to the "End Polio Now" campaign by throwing money in a yellow bucket held by Rotarian Volunteers. The net proceeds to Polio Plus for the evening was \$7,543.58. This compares to about \$4,000 raised for the same event last year. **The Ankeny Club has received a check for \$238.48** for our share of the proceeds based on the number of tickets we purchased.

## **Attandance at Rotary meetings**

Each club sets it's own guidelines for membership but we should all keep in mind the Standard Rotary Club Constitution that specifies three conditions under which a Rotarian's membership will automatically be terminated for nonattendance.

These three conditions are: failure to attend or make up four consective club meetings, failure to attend or make up 60 percent of club meetings each six months, and failure to attend at least 30 percent of the meetings of one's own club in each six-month period. Under any of these three cases, a member could lose their Rotary membership unless the club board of directors consents to excuse the member for good reason.

It is recognized that it is not possible for most members to attend every meeting but the Ankeny Club offers many opportunities to receve credits for makeups by attending board meetings, attending committee meetings, online makeups, and participating in social events . The Ankeny club currently has 18 members with perfect atendance through the first three quarters of the 2009-2010 fiscal year.

As we begin the last quarter of the year, this would be a good time to check your attendance record to make sure you have been credited with all meetings you have attended and any makeups that you have earned. You can check your attendance by going to our web site and logging in. Then go to *My Attendance* in the *My ClubRunner* section. Please report any discrepancies to Nate Burnham. In the next couple weeks, Nate plans to contact those that are close to perfect attendance to let them know how many makeups they need to get to 100% before year end.
