Congratulations New Paul Harris Fellows

During the past two weeks we awarded Sally Schroeder with her Paul Harris times two pin and recognized Trent Murphy for becoming a new Paul Harris Fellow. Congratulations to Sally and Trent!!

The Paul Harris Fellowship is named for Paul Harris who founded Rotary with three business associates in Chicago in 1905. The Fellowship was established in 1957 to express appreciation for a contribution of \$1,000 to the humanitarian and educational programs of The Rotary Foundation. Those programs include an array of projects that save and invigorate the lives of people around the world and enhance international friendship and understanding. These programs are funded, implemented, and managed by Rotarians and Rotary clubs around the globe.

When a Rotarian's contributions to the Foundation reaches a total of \$1,000, they become a Paul Harris Fellow and receive a certificate, lapel pin and medallion. The certificate states that the recipiant has been named a Paul Harris Fellow, "in recognition of tangible and significant assistance given for the furtherance of better understanding and friendly relations between peoples of the world." When a recipient has contributed a total of \$2,000, they become a multiple donor, Paul Haris times two, and receive a lapel pin with one saffire stone in it. A new pin with additional safires is presented to a donor for each additional \$1,000 contributed.

Volunteers Needed for Veterns

Central Iowa Rotarians have been asked to consider providing volunteers for the 2010 National Veteran's Golden Age Games to be held in Des Moines from May 25th to June 1st.

This event is like a Senior and Special Olympics and is open to all eligible Veterns. This year, Des Moines was chosen to host this event and it is even more special this year since the games are a qualifying event for the Senior Olympics. It is projected that over 700 veterns will come to Des Moines along with their families and friends to participate in 14 events and nightly activities. Events will be held downtown and throughout sites in the city and include swimming, bicycling, golf, shot-put, discus, 10-meter air rifle, table tennis, dominoes, shuffelboard, horseshoes, nine-ball, bowling, checkers, and croquet. Each event has seven age categories for participation, as well as visually impaired and wheelchair divisions.

A total of 2000 volunteers will be needed for the week and anyone over the age of 16 can help. All volunteers will receive training on the rules for the events they will help with and a t-shirt. If you are interested in helping out with this event contact Nate Burnham for more information.
