RI "New" Strategic Plan

In 2001-02 as Rotary International entered its second century of service, it began developing a stratrateg plan to guide the organization. The plan has been reviewed and updates periodically since.

In 2009 , the Board conducted an extensive review of the *RI Strategic Plan*. This review included surveying 14,000 Rotarians worldwide about the organization's priorities, conducting focus groups to assess Rotary's image in different countries, and analyzing other data and research. The revised plan, effective July 1, 2010, reflects the results of this research and also unifies the strategfic direction of RI and the Rotary Foundation and includes th efollowing:

Mission - We provide service to others, promote integrity, and advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through our fellowship of business, professional, and community leaders.

Vision - We will be the service organization of choice with dynamic, action-oriented clubs whose contributions improve lives in communities worldwide.

Core Values - Rotary's core values represent the guiding principles of the organization's culture, including what guides member's priorities and actions within the organization. Values are an increasingly important component in strategic planning because they drive the intent and direction of the organization's leadership. These core values are: **Service**, **Fellowship**, **Diversity**, **Integrity**, and **Leadership**.
