

Rotary Service Project to Ghana

Have you ever considered traveling with other Rotarians on an immunization trip? If so, here is an opportunity you may want to consider.

This is not a polio eradication exercise but a group is being sent to Ghana for Guinea worm and a variety of other health needs. You get up early in the morning travel with local Rotarians to a village, health clinic or improverished neighborhood and for the next several hours you change. Small children come up to you to throw open their mouths with the trust that you will help them. Mothers and fathers smile at you knowing that you are giving their child a chance for a better life. It is hot, it is dusty, it is uncomfortable, it is exquisite.

The trip is from November 3-12, 2010. The Rotarians will travel to Accra, Ghana, West Africa to attend the 6th Annual West Africa Project fair, participate in village immunization programs modeled after the polio NID programs and engage with local Rotarians in a community of service.
