Rotary Foundation Update

Th Rotary FoundatoChir announced on the last day, May 25th, of the Rotary International Convention in New Orleans that Rotrians hve contribted \$173,407,000 towards the 200 Million Challenge.

Rotary's \$200 Million Challenge is the Rotary Foundation's response to the two grants totaling \$355 million from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation to help eradicate polio. Every dollar given to PolioPlus will be counted toward the \$200 million match, which must be completed by 30 June 2012.
