2011-2012 Rotary Theme

Rotary International President-elect Kalyan Banerjee anounced his theme for 2011-2012 at the 2011 International Assembly in San Diego, California in January. His theme will be: "Reach Within to Embrace Humanity".



Do you know when the first annual Rotary theme was announced and what it was? In 1955, RI President A.Z. Baker announced a theme, "Develop Our Resources" to serve as Rotary's program of emphasis. Since that time, each president has issued a theme for his Rotary year. The shortest theme was in 1961-62 when Joseph Abey selected "Act". Other one-word themes were chosen in 1957-58 by Charles Tennent, "Serve" and 1968-1969 by Kiyoshis Togasaki, "Participate"
