Club Directories On-Line

Did you know there are three different club directories available to you on line through our web site?

You can view the directories and print a copy by going to our web site, www.anken Rotary.org then log in. After you log in, click on "**Admin**" and under "**My ClubRunner**" you will see the following three directories:

View Club Directories - This list contains each "Active" member by name, email address, and phone number. If you need to contact a member you can send them an email by just clicking on their email address in this directory. You can also view their address by clicking on their name.

View Club Photo Directory - By clicking on this link you will see a picture of each member, both Active and Honorary, and their contact information including email address, mailing address, and phone number, and their spouse's name. Again, you can send the member an email by simply clicking on their address

View Printable Directory and Mailing Lables - After clicking on this email, click on "**View Word**". This will bring up a Word document with all members listed including a picture and all contact information. You can save this document or print it as you would any Word document. The Administrator can also use this link to create mailling lables.
