District 6000 Recognizes Interact Clubs

During the Rotary District 6000 Conference, April 12-13 at Honey Creek Resort State Park, the 50 years of Interact was honored. Interact, a Rotary sponsored youth service club, was launched by the Rotary International Board of Directors in 1962. The first Interact club was established by the Rotary Club of Melbourne, Florida. Interact clubs provide opportunities for young people of secondary school age to work

together in a world fellowship of service and international understanding. The term "Interact" is derived from "inter" for international and "act" for action.

All clubs, including Ankeny, that sponsor an Interact club were recognized and presented a framed certificate of recognition. This certificate will be delivered to the Ankeny Interact Club.

Roll Call of Shoes Nets 3,739 Pairs

One of the features of the 2013 Rotary District Conference was a "Roll Call of Shoes" to benefit Samaritan's Feet and the Blessman Ministries. During the "Roll Call" each club was asked to respond with the number of pairs of shoes and cash that they had brought to the conference. Thanks in part to the 100 pairs brought by Gary & Colleen

Welch, the Rotary Club of Ankeny was able to report that we brought 166 pairs of shoes. All shoes were stacked around the fireplace at Honey Creek Lodge.

The most shoes were brought by the Rotary Club of Decatur County, a club with only 20 members, that brought 743 pairs of shoes. In total, 3,241 pairs of shoes and \$7,472 for "Virtual shoes", to be purchased, were reported. At \$15 per virtual pair of shoes, the total pairs of shoes that will be shipped to Africa will be \$3,739. Since a few clubs were not present to answer the roll call, it is hoped additional shoes will be delivered so District Governor Geiger will meet his goal of 4,000 pairs of shoes.
